Victorville's Southern California Logistics Airport (SCLA) is home to Foreign Trade Zone #243. As a federally designated area, a Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ) is considered outside U.S. Customs territory for international trade purposes.

SCLA's Foreign Trade Zone comprises 1,954 acres, and provides unique financial savings to businesses involved in most any type of international trade including shipments to the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. Foreign merchandise may be admitted into a zone with limited customs entry filing or paying of U.S. Customs duties and government excise taxes. Foreign and domestic merchandise admitted to a zone may be exhibited, stored, tested, sampled, relabeled, repackaged, mixed, manipulated and destroyed. The cost savings and faster turnaround times realized by Foreign Trade Zones allow businesses to remain competitive in a global market.

As an added incentive, SCLA's Foreign Trade Zone can work in conjunction with the airport's U.S. Customs bonded warehouse. This provides companies additional cost savings by allowing certain bonded merchandise to be transferred to SCLA, cancelling the bond or time limit applicable to traditional bonded warehouses, making possible an immediate recovery of taxes already paid.

Southern California Logistics Airport (SCLA) is an 8,500 acre industrial park offering immediate access via rail, truck and air cargo transportation.
